// WHAT DOES CENTRIQ COST?

- A one-year subscription to Centriq is included with the Ultimate Home Inspection. If clients were to subscribe to Centriq on their own it costs \$60 and does not include the Centriq Insights report.
- Centriq sends an email to your client to renew their subscription with a discount at the end of the year.
- If they choose not to renew, your client keeps access to everything that

DID YOU KNOW

It is illegal to sell a recalled product. That includes selling a home with a recalled item in it.

Centriq can decode the date of manufacture from just the serial number for 50 of the major brands in appliances and heating and cooling.

An estimated \$700 Billion is spent annually on property damage, injuries and deaths due to faulty consumer products. That's more than \$2100 per US household annually!

Every 1 in 2 homes contains something recalled, 1 in 38 inspections has an appliance or HVAC item recalled.

I use an app called Centriq that is included in our Ultimate Home Inspection. With it I can scan every appliance and piece of equipment in your home, and it gives me:

- The age and remaining useful life,
- It tells me if any of it has an outstanding safety recall,
- And since you get the app with our Ultimate Home Inspection, it'll keep monitoring for safety recalls for as long as you keep the app.

And you can add everything else you own so it monitors all of it. Electronics, power tools, sports equipment, all your gear and gadgets.

Did you know that on average one in two homes in America contains at least one recalled item? Just scan everything you own and see if you can find one.

We see a recalled product during our inspections every 38 homes or so, and that's just for the major appliances and heating and cooling equipment we capture. Some of those recalls are pretty serious too, with risk of fire or bodily injury.

The app also gives you quick access to all the manuals and other documents related to each product, plus it has one-click access to all the right parts, like filters, etcetera, and handy videos on how to operate and maintain these products, like how-to replace that filter. It can also be a great start to your insurance inventory.

I think having Centriq will give you a lot of peace of mind for years to come. Plus, don't you want to know if anything is recalled before you close on this home?
